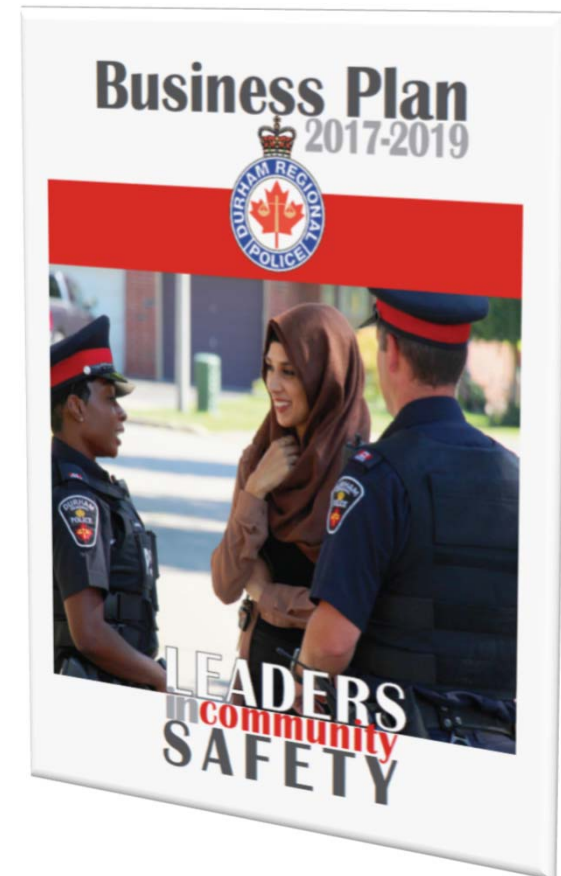

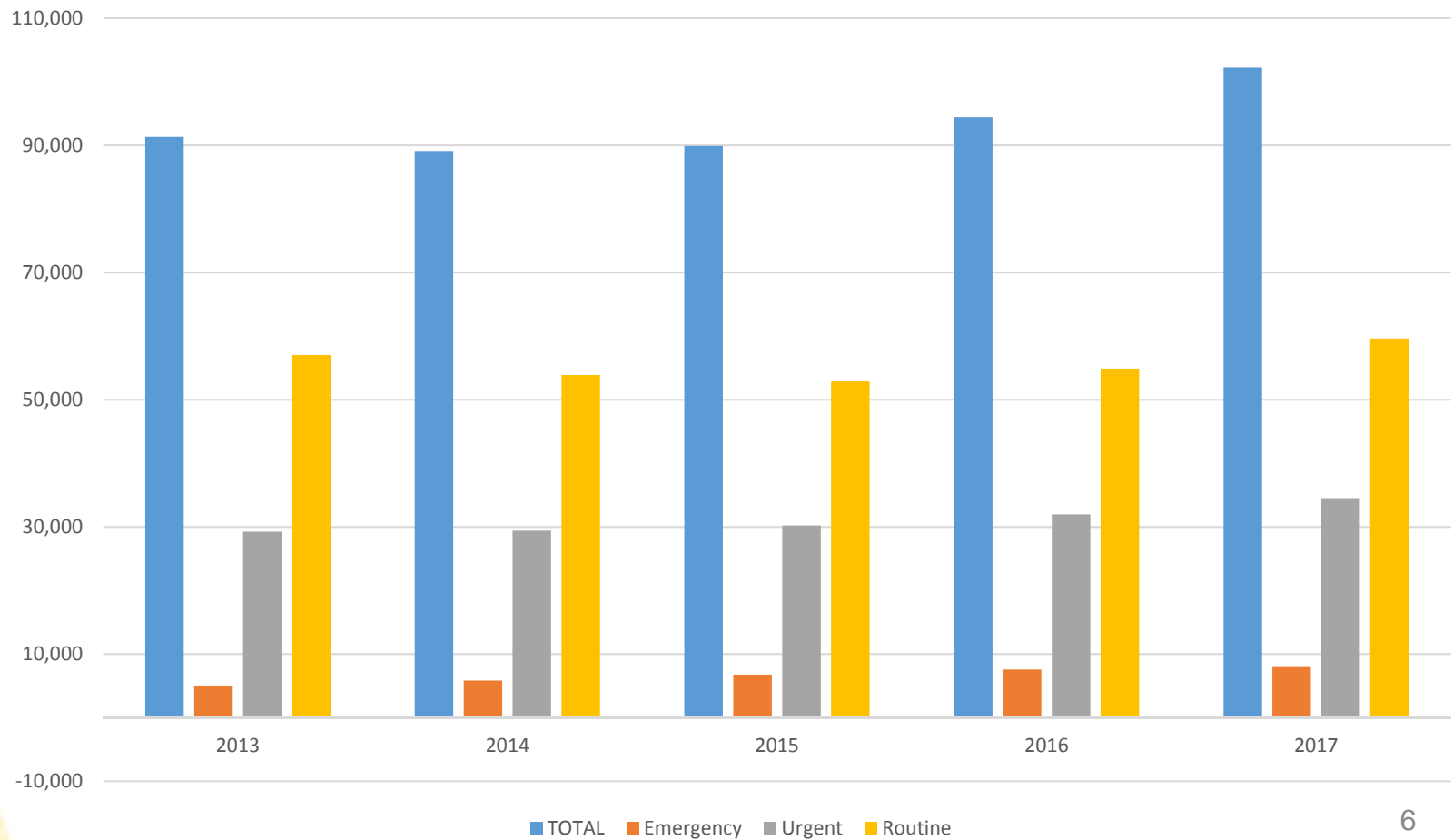

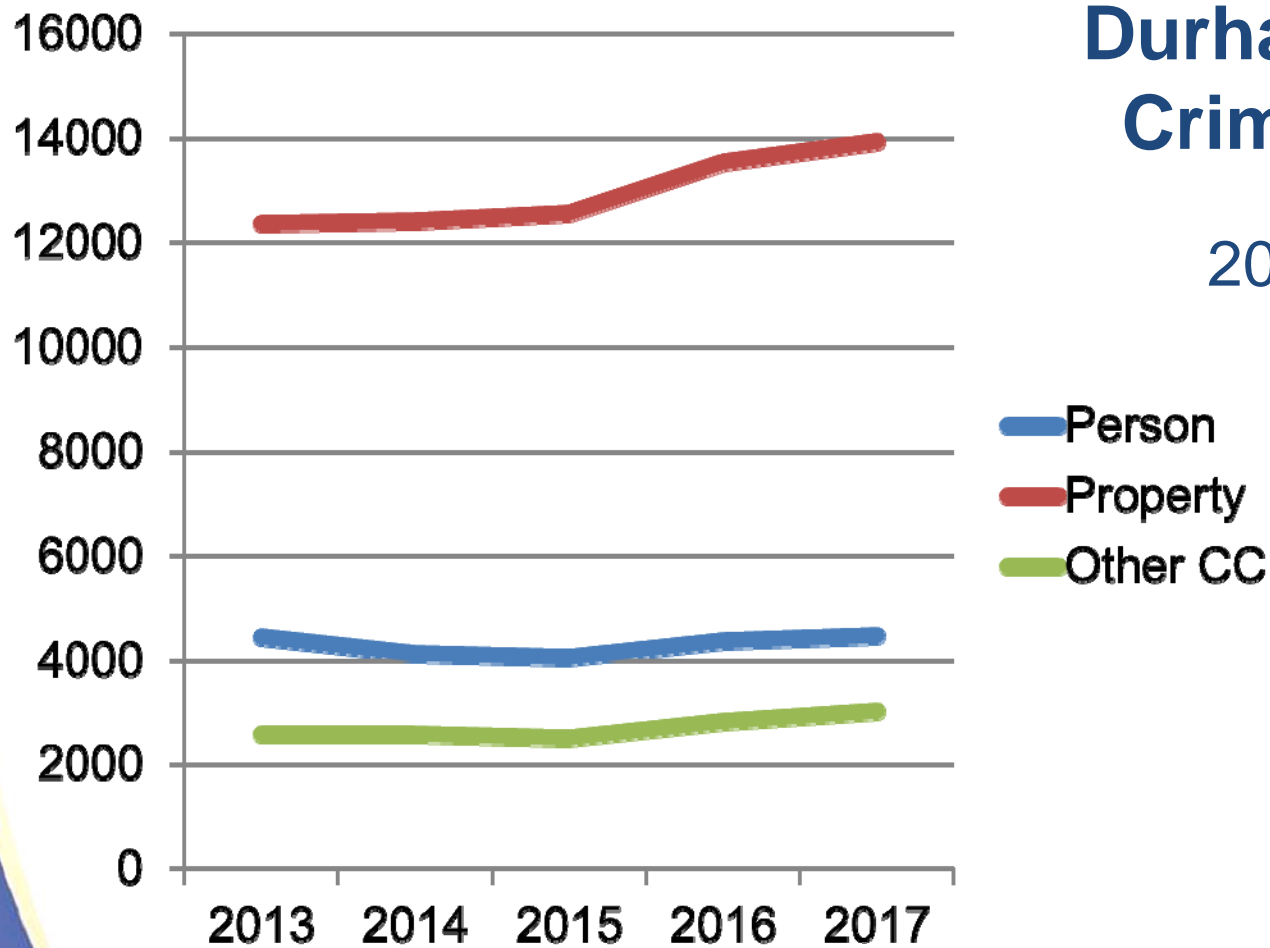
Calls for Service 2013-2017

2017 vs. 2016: Going Down

	2017	% Drop
Assault with Weapon	408	-6.6%
Break & Enter	1,252	-2.3%
Fraud	2,400	-7.7%
MVC – Injury	1,663	-3.9%



2017 vs. 2016: Unchanged

MVC Property Damage	7,537	7,506
Dangerous Operation	37	37
MVC Fatal	21	21



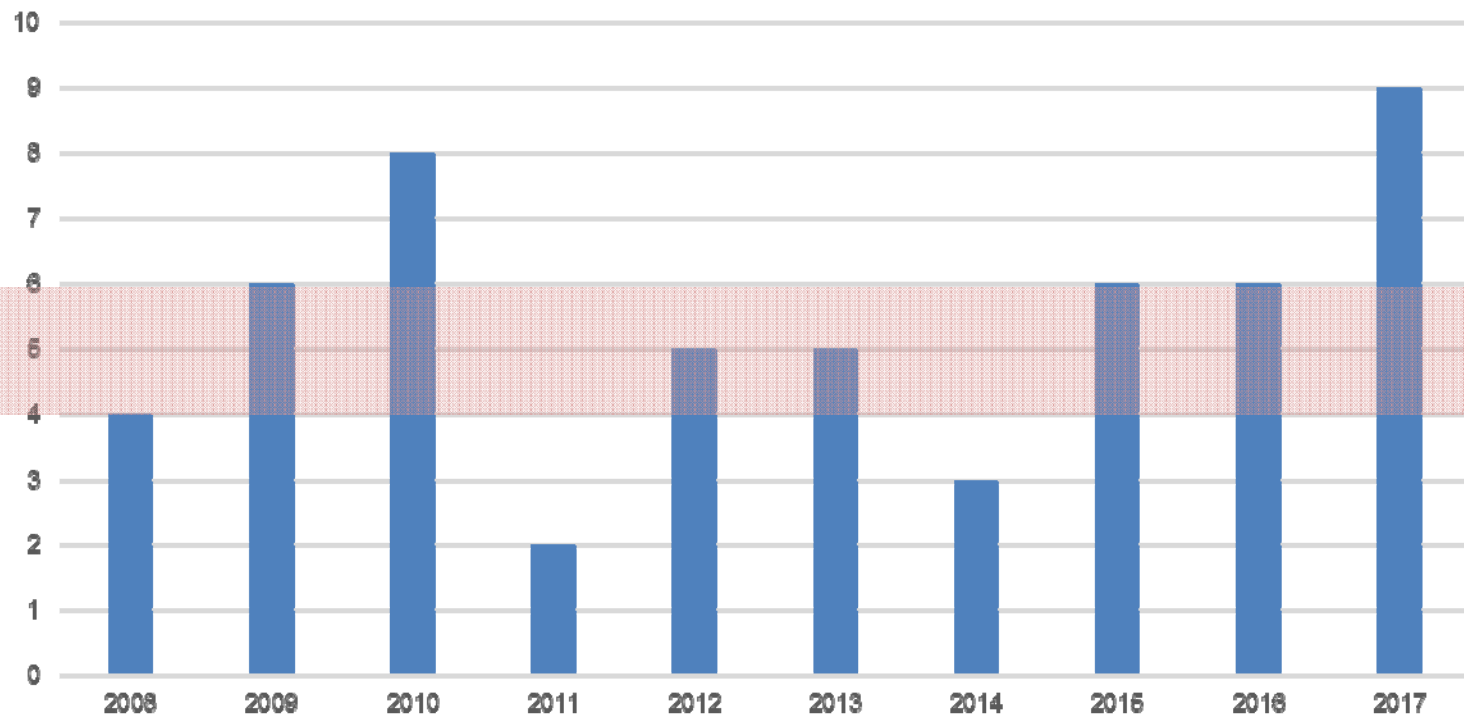
2017 vs. 2016: Going Up

	2017	% Increase
Assaults	2,157	1.8%
Sexual Violations	525	3.8%
Robbery	363	17.5%
Theft	3,718	6.5%

Recent Successes

- Two brothers facing a combined 66 charges for car jacking/robbery incidents in north Ajax
- Festive RIDE arrested 112 motorists for drinking and driving offences, up from 99 the previous year

Future Challenges

- The Safer Ontario Act (Bill 175) will result in significant changes to policing in Ontario
- It has passed Second Reading and has been referred to the Standing Committee on Justice Policy
- Public hearings are scheduled for the end of February and beginning of March.



Future Challenges

- New marihuana law expected to begin in late summer 2018 – clock is ticking regarding time needed for training
- Aging population and the challenges associated with our vulnerable sector
- Traffic management, texting while driving, driving impaired by drug or alcohol
